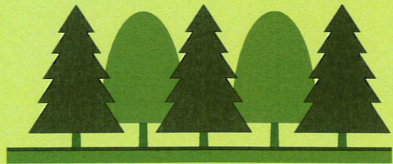

The following items will be accepted at the collection at the following prices to residents:

- 50¢ per circular light tube
- 60¢ per 4' or less tube
- 85¢ per > 4' tube
- \$1.75 per 4' or less shatter shield tube
- \$2.25 per > 4' shatter shield tube
- \$2.00 per tanning bed bulb
- \$2.50 per H.I.D. light bulb

PROPER DISPOSAL OF MERCURY WASTE & LEAD

Simple household items can contain heavy metals and mercury that can contaminate rivers, lakes and fish if not properly disposed of. Bring the following items from your home to our household hazardous waste collection so they can be recycled or managed properly:

- Lead tackle/ Split shot/Weights
- Mercury batteries
- Button batteries
- Thermostats and switches
- Fluorescent and HID lamps
- Some types of old paint
- Liquid mercury
- Thermometers
